Exelon is making a motion to include the Exelon revisions to the NUCRA within PJM's Interconnection Reform proposal that was previously endorsed at the 4/27 MC meeting

# Purpose of Network Upgrade Cost Responsibility Agreement (NUCRA)

- The NUCRA is a cost responsibility agreement for Project Developers that have been assigned cost allocation for shared system upgrades (e.g. *Common Use Upgrades*) necessary for the interconnections of their new service requests.
- PJM determines the cost allocation to be assigned to each responsible Project Developer for the shared system upgrades.
- The TOs are not assigned any responsibilities within the NUCRA.

**As such, Exelon proposes to modify the NUCRA to remove the TO from being a party.**

# Exelon Proposal - Modify Parties to the NUCRA

- The proposal does not change the MRC endorsed PJM IPRTF Package but provides clarification of who the responsible parties are within the agreement .
- **Purpose of Proposal**
  - Remove the TO from being a party to the NUCRA since TO has no responsibilities in the agreement.
  - Include TO acknowledgement that the NUCRA has been reviewed by the TO.
- **Snapshot of Proposal**
  - “This Network Upgrade Cost Responsibility Agreement (“NUCRA”) including the Schedules and Appendices attached hereto and incorporated herein, is entered into by and between PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“Transmission Provider” or “PJM”) and the following Project Developers. ~~and the Transmission Owner:~~”
  - **Addition - “The signature below of the authorized officer of the Transmission Owner is for the limited purpose of acknowledging that an authorized officer of said Transmission Owner has read this Agreement as of this \_\_\_ day of \_\_\_, 20\_\_.”**
