

Regional Planning Process <u>Task Force Report</u> <u>PJM Interconnection – Markets and Reliability Committee</u> July 31, 2014

The Regional Planning Process Task Force (RPPTF) last met on July 16, 2014.

The RPPTF has completed its review of final language for the definition of "Supplemental Project" within the PJM Operating Agreement. The definition is now in the process of being approved through the MRC and MC.

Work is progressing on establishing a Window Proposal Fee to be wrapped up and in place by the end of the year. PJM will bring a straw proposal for the Window Proposal Fee to the next RPPTF meeting, providing a framework for discussion on costs, fee structure, etc. PJM will also provide education on what constitutes a proposal.

The RPPTF is also investigating Generation Interconnection as a potential MDA driver. The next meeting will continue with further education and stakeholder discussion as to whether there is interest in pursuing this issue.
