## **PAH Ramp Rate Proposal**

- Weakens the 'no excuse' policy for performance of Capacity Performance resources
- Directly against the Commission's determination on excusing non-performance due to any operating parameter
- Alleged problem of excessive self-scheduling is not supported
- If resources self-schedule in anticipation of PAH, PAH would not be triggered
- During capacity shortage, most of the available capacity is expected to be producing energy or providing reserves

## **Actual Performance**

- **Actual Performance includes energy output and** any reserve and regulation assignment
- PJM's examples ignore reserve and regulation assignment used in Performance Shortfall calculation
- Resources can also self-schedule reserves and regulation, in addition to energy
