

Interconnection Queue Status Update

- FERC accepted PJM's filing on August 23rd to have a soft close of the Interconnection Queue on September 10th and March 10th
 - The AH1 Queue will close on September 10th, 2021
 - Completed applications received between September 11 and September 30 will not be accepted
 - AH2 Queue window is October 1, 2021 to March 10th, 2022



Queue Delays

 At the May PC, PJM announced the delay of the AG2 Queue to at least January 2022

• PJM is extending the AG2 delay to at least July 2022

• PJM is announcing that the AH1 queue will be delayed until at least January 2023



Backlog Focus

• AG2 queue size of 657 and AH1 set to close in September

- PJM is also be deferring project modification requests for the AG2 and AH1 queues
 - A project change window will be announced and held prior to commencing study work on these queues



Backlog Focus

• Continued focus on the backlogged studies

- Continue to on-board and train new staff
 - The interconnection departments experienced staff turnover
 - Those positions have been backfilled and several new positions have been filled



Current Backlog Retool and Delayed Queue Schedules

AD1/AD2	September / October
AE1/AE2	November / December
AF1/AF2	January / February
AG1	March

- AG2 case build scheduled for April 2022
- AH1 case build scheduled for October 2022
