

Load Management Testing Reminders

(December Testing)

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- The most recent tests under the new rules occurred on:
 - December 6 for AEP zone
 - December 8 for PECO zone

- Next steps:
 - Retest
 - Test Emergency Energy Settlements
 - Compliance



- Retest (if desired) can only determine performance once all registrations in zone are tested (summer only + annual):
 - If test reductions > 75% of commitment, CSP can self schedule retest(s) in DR Hub (must be in same season)
 - If test reductions <= 75% of commitment, CSP has 46 days from the test date to request that PJM schedule a single retest
 - AEP zone by January 21
 - PECO zone by January 23

Emergency Energy Settlements

- Submit test energy settlements within 60 days of test event
 - AEP zone by February 4, 2024
 - PECO zone by February 6, 2024
- CBLs
 - Generally, for AEP zone tests, CSP will need to upload 24 hours of daily load data for the following dates to calculate the 3 Day Types with SAA CBL:
 - November 29, 30 December 1, 4, 5, 2023
 - Generally, for PECO zone tests, CSP will need to upload 24 hours of daily load data for the following dates to calculate the 3 Day Types with SAA CBL:
 - December 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 2023



- CSP Retest (initial test > 75%)
 - Start/end instructions sent from DR Hub in response to normal CSP polling according to registrations' lead time
 - Email sent at notification time
- PJM Retest (initial test <= 75%)
 - Day Before PJM Retest Date:
 - Load Management/PRD Retest Summary event(s) posted to DR Hub Events section by 10:00 EPT the day before retest date
 - CSP should monitor DR Hub webpage and/or use web service function to obtain retest date
 - Since retests are CSP specific they are not posted to the Test webpage
 - Email sent by 10:00 EPT the day before retest date
 - Event Day
 - Start/end instructions sent from DR Hub in response to normal CSP polling according to registrations' lead time
 - Email sent at notification time

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- Compliance will be determined after the Delivery Year
- Only registrations that have not been part of a Load Management Event during the DY will be subject to capability demonstration by test
