- 1. Welcome, Announcements and Anti-trust and Code of Conduct announcement
 - A. WebEx report was used for attendance.

 - D. Andrea Yeaton provided information related to 2021/2022 Delivery Year (DY) Load Management Registration Window. The Window opened on 1/4/21. The pre-registration process for existing resources in Capacity Exchange starts on 1/18/2021. New registrations must be registered by 5/14/2021. The complete registration process must be completed by 5/31/21 at 23:50 (11:50 pm).

A repeat of the Load Management Registration training will occur on 2/11/21 0900 (9:00 am) – 1100 (11:00 am).

The communication sent to DR Hub Users may be confusing. For clarification, MOPR applies to the 2022/2023 DY.

For any Unit Specific Exemption requests, please send an email to the RPM Hotline, so PJM can model the exemption. The IMM should still be contacted, so it can be modeled in MIRA.

E. Brief update/discussion of DR related activity in other stakeholder groups – MIC, OC, PC, or other The PRD Credit Disposition is up for endorsement at the January MIC.

DRS members are encouraged to participate in the DER and Inverter-Based Resources Subcommittee (DIRS), because the group will be working on Order 2222. This order has implications that affect DER and DR resources.

2. Pete Langbein reviewed activity from last year and solicited thoughts for 2021.

The 2020/2021 Delivery Year (DY) was the first with no base resources. This resulted in a large increase in load data coordination and the overall process worked well. Thank you to all members for making this a success

The new Load Management Testing requirements will start in the 2023/2024 DY.

The Peak Shaving Adjustment was not implemented in DR Hub as there weren't any PSA Plans submitted. Therefore the implementation will be postponed until next year.

Potential topics to cover at the DRS in 2021:





Investigate potential Customer Baseline changes. There is language in OATT that discusses this, so it can be discussed at DRS meetings based on member priorities.

Investigate circumstances if/when DR resources could provide transmission solutions. Recommend having Transmission Planning education with a focus how DR resources can be included.

FERC Order 2222 settlement process for DR and how it may affect DR participation. Will PJM's model change as a result of the 2222 Order? It is recommended that DRS members follow the DIRS but that PJM does not expect the existing DR model to change

A request to discuss DR Fast Start Resources was made. This topic was covered at the November 2020 DRS. Members are asked to review the presentation and forward any questions/comments to the Demand Response Operations team at PJM.
