

## Home Area Network Gateway as an Alternative Metering Solution

## Background:

- Utility AMI meters have ability to measure/record sub-hourly intervals but utilities typically only capture/retain hourly intervals
  - Sub-hourly example: Synch Reserve Market participation where 1 minute intervals are required.
  - Typically Pulse Data Recorders used to capture sub-hourly intervals
    - (KYZ Pulse output required on meter)

## Problem:

- Utility deploys AMI meters without KYZ Pulse outputs
  - PDR cannot be used
- Home Area Network Gateways:
  - Device (wireless) to receive sub-hourly intervals from AMI meter
    - Utility approved devices/authentication
    - Must meet PJM Tariff protocol of 2% error over metering system
