- Stakeholders endorsed to add additional time and days to the Power Meter & Inschedule deadlines to ensure greater accuracy
 - Effective date of June 1, 2015.

- Current deadlines to submit to PJM
 - Power Meter
 - Monday Sunday* = Next Business Day at 4pm EPT
 - Inschedule
 - Monday Sunday* = Two Business Days after 4pm EPT

*Includes after Holidays



Current Concerns and Impacts

- Missing daily deadlines
 - If PJM re-opens Power Meter portal for late submittal, then
 - InSchedule needs to be reopen for resubmission of load carve outs (Participant)
 - Coordinate Inschedule reopening, hours in processing time (PJM)
 - If PJM re-opens InSchedule portal for late submittal, then
 - Delays in accurate settlement postings (Participant)
 - Hours in processing time and reporting (PJM)
 - Settlements has the potential to be inaccurate for up to 60 days
- Daylight Saving submittals
 - Doubling an hour, instead of putting values in extra hour
 - Skipping incorrect hour
 - Shifting hours
