# 1. ADMINISTRATION (9:30-9:45)

- Mr. Anders opened the meeting and reviewed the agenda.
- Mr. Chmielewski reviewed the meeting guidelines, performed roll call and reviewed the draft minutes. Minutes were approved and posted as final.
- Mr. Chmielewski reviewed the open action items. All current items are closed. Action item responses can be viewed <a href="https://example.com/here.">here.</a>

## 2. REVIEW POSTED EDUCATION MATERIALS (9:45-12:11)

- Mr. Ott, PJM Interconnection, LLC, shared his thoughts on the initial design and development of ARRs and FTRs. He suggested the group come to an expedited decision as to whether or not the Senior Task Force would benefit from a broader scope, which would consider what the stakeholders desire the ARR and FTR product definitions encompass (e.g. simple allocation of congestions revenues, hedge against Day-Ahead congestion, etc.).
- Several members agreed that a broader scope directed at the definition of the FTR product, as well as the fundamental issue of property rights, would benefit the group. It was the group consensus to report back to the August 21st MRC meeting with a revised issue charge, problem statement, and charter.
- Mr. Anders noted that PJM staff will create and distribute an altered draft issue charge, problem statement, and charter prior to the next MRC meeting. It was also the group consensus that PJM and IMM staffs collectively draft polling questions to better understand all stakeholder positions moving forward. These questions along with the draft issue charge, problem statement, and charter will be distributed to the FTRSTF mailing list for comments prior to official polling.

### BREAK (10:45-11:00)

- Mr. Horger presented further education material on ARR/FTR Underfunding in response to several additional data requests from the July 16<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- Mr. Singh, J. Aron & Company, presented congestion accounting in a multi-settlement market.
- Howard Haas, Monitoring Analytics, presented examples for balancing congestions as well as follow up information for three outstanding action items.



# 3. <u>LUNCH (12:11-1:00)</u>

 Howard Haas, Monitoring Analytics, continued a presentation highlighting several examples of how injections and withdraws impact total congestion dollars.

- Mr. Anders recapped the day's agenda, and then asked the group for comments and suggestions for the draft charter and polling questions.
- Several members expressed concerns with a broader scope given the need for a decision by January 2015. However, the group consensus was to move forward with an altered charter, pending MRC approval.
