

## MIC Special Sessions Unit Notification and Start-up Times Update to MRC (Aug 17, 2011)

The following is an outline summary of the MIC Special Sessions for Unit Notification and Startup Times:

## A. Background:

- 1. Charge from MRC for OC to determine minimum reliability requirements for unit notification and start-up.
- 2. OC completed determination of the minimum reliability requirements for start-up and notification
- 3. OC worked through minimum reliability requirements in Feb–Mar, and reviewed at MRC and MIC in April.
- 4. MIC settled on having special MIC sessions to address market rules associated with reliability requirements.
- 5. MIC Special Sessions conducted on:
  - April 29 May 13 May 23 July 14 Aug 16
- B. Status:
  - 1. Focus has been on the problem investigation part of the GAST process including identification of markets issues to support OC items, grouping in categories, identifying stakeholder interests and prioritizing.
  - 2. The following solution components have been identified :
    - a. More than 6 days startup plus notification time
    - b. Aborted notification costs

- c. Start-up time guidelines
- d. Notification time guidelines
- e. Application to both price and cost based schedules
- f. Timing for changes to market rules
- g. More than 48 hours and less than 6 days startup plus notification time
- 3. Solution options of each of the above component have been identified and discussed.

## C. Next Steps:

- 1. Request participants to package component options into proposals and send them to PJM by Sep 6.
- 2. Will discuss suggested proposals at the next meeting:
