# 1. ADMINISTRATION



- A. Mr. Herling called the meeting to order and asked if the Planning Committee had any additional items for the agenda. There were no suggestions for additional agenda items.
- B. Mr. Herling noted that attendance would be taken by roll call sheets being circulated at the Planning Committee meetings moving forward. He also noted that WebEx attendees would be captured through their login credentials. After which, Mr. Herling asked Mr. Herman to review the minutes. Then Mr. Herman reviewed the meeting minutes of the September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2014 Planning Committee meeting. Mr. Pratzon then made a motion to approve the minutes. Ms. Krizenoskas seconded the motion. In a voice vote, the Planning Committee approved the September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2014 Planning Committee minutes.
- C. Mr. Herling provided an update on the Directional Carrier Blocking Charge Statement, informing the Planning Committee that this charge statement has been formally assigned to the Relay Subcommittee
- D. Mr. Kumar from PJM's Operations Support department led an informational presentation on updates to the Eastern Interface definition. This change resulted from the addition of the Lackawnna-Hopatcong line as part of the Susquehanna-Roseland project.
- E. Ms. Reiter provided an informational presentation on updates to PJM's Manual 03 resulting from the biannual review.

# 2. NERC/RRO UPDATE

Ms. Wesely provided the Planning Committee with an update on recent NERC activities and PJM compliance activities. This update included discussions of several standards under development including several PRC standards. Ms. Wesley pointed out that although NERC will be moving to a new acronym "RAS" (Remedial Action Scheme), PJM will continue the use of the term SPS (Special Protection Scheme) in its manuals.

# 3. TO/TOP MATRIX

This item was removed from the Planning Committee Agenda, and will be discussed at a future meeting.

### 4. SMART INVERTERS PROPOSAL PACKAGE

Ms. Keshavamurthy presented PJM's recommended package for enhanced inverters. The presentation included key work activities accomplished by the group; a Process recap, Polling results including 98.55% of respondents in support of PJM's package; Applicability; Package details and next steps. Mr. Herling asked the Planning Committee to endorse the recommended package for enhance inverters. Mr. Chu made a motion to endorse the enhanced inverter package. Mr. Donelson seconded the motion. IN A VOICE VOTE, THE PLANNING COMMITTEE ENDORSED PJM'S RECOMMENDED PACKAGE FOR ENHNACED INVERTERS.\*

# 5. MANUAL 14A CHANGES FOR SMALL GENERATOR

Ms. Shea provided a review of PJM Manual 14A changes regarding Small Generator Interconnection Procedures pre-application process. These changes are required by Order 792 and will become effective November 1, 2014 pending committee endorsement. Mr. Herling asked the Planning Committee to endorse the changes to M14A for Small Generator Interconnection Procedures pre-application process. Mr. Bailey made a motion to endorse the M14A changes. Ms. Esposito seconded the motion. IN A VOICE VOTE, THE PLANNING COMMITTEE ENDORSED THE CHANGES TO M14A FOR SMALL GENERATOR INTERCONNECTION PROCEDURES PRE-APPLICATION PROCESS.\*



# 6. 2014 IRM STUDY RESULTS

Mr. Rocha reviewed the 2014 IRM study results. This review included a decomposition of the change; Historical weighted-average forced outage rates and details of the IRM, FPR and DR Factor for delivery years 2015/16, 2016/17, 2017/18 and 2018/19. Additionally Mr. Rocha reviewed the Winter Weekly Reserve Target Value for upcoming 2014/15 winter operating period. Mr. Herling asked the Planning Committee to endorse the 2014 IRM Study results. Ms. Esposito made a motion to endorse the 2014 IRM Study results. Mr. Pratzon seconded the motion. IN A VOICE VOTE, THE PLANNING COMMITTEE ENDORSED THE 2014 IRM STUDY RESUTS.\*

# 7. SECURING M03 SECTION 5 FROM UNRESTRICTED PUBLIC ACCESS

Mr. Tam discussed the recent change to the posting of Manual 3 (Transmission Operations) due to CEII concerns. Mr. Tam noted that the intention of change is not to limit access to anyone who has a legitimate need, but to ensure proper CEII rules are followed.

## 8. PJM MANUAL 14B UPDATE FOR PRC-023-3

Mr. Habtemichael provided a first read of draft changes to PJM Manual 14B for PRC-023-3. Mr. Habtemichael stated that these changes are minor, and if anything will result in less faciliites included on the PRC-023 list. Mr. Habtemichael will return to the November Planning Committee seeking endorsement of these changes.

## 9. TPL-001-4 R1 AND R7 REVIEW

Mr. Sims will reviewed M14B language previously approved by the Planning Committee for upcoming TPL-001-4 Requirements R1 and R7. Mr. Sims presented a first read of a modification to M14B language for R1 which was previously approved by the Planning Committee. Mr. Sims will return to the November Planning Committee seeking endorsement of this modification.

### 10. REVIEW OF MOD-032 PROCESS CHANGES

Mr. Thompson discussed upcoming changes to planning data requests regarding MOD-032. Mr. Thompson stated that he will return to a future Planning Committee Meeting to discuss additional details of this process change including data requirements and collection procedures.

# 11. PSEG ER&T PROBLEM STATEMENT

Mr. Carretta from PSEG presented a first read of the Problem Statement regarding Firm Injection Rights and Firm Withdrawal Rights. Mr. Carretta stated that he will return to the November Planning Committee seeking endorsement of this problem statement.

### 12. PROPOSAL WINDOW LESSONS LEARNED

Mr. Barrett led a discussion on the results of the PJM Window Process – Lessons learned poll. Mr. Barrett reviewed the top voted items and sought feedback on proper grouping of these items. Mr. Barrett also asked the Planning Committee members how they wanted to structure reviews of these items. Collectively the group discussed setting up a series of webex discussions to work through these groupings of lessons. Additionally, Mr. Barrett discussed other items already underway to address lessons learned from previous proposal windows. These currently underway items include communications, submission of secure, large files, and access to data.
