# 1. ADMINISTRATION

- A. Mr. Herling called the meeting to order and asked if the Planning Committee had any additional items for the agenda. Mr. Pratzon suggested a topic for discussion regarding the planning impacts of the AEP decision to divide its territory into 4 separate zones for energy pricing purposes. Mr. Herling led a discussion on this topic, concluding that this division would not impact planning analysis, and therefore did not require any changes to planning processes.
- B. Mr. Herman reviewed the meeting minutes of the October 9th, 2014 Planning Committee meeting. Mr. Chu then made a motion to approve the minutes. Mr. Carretta seconded the motion. In a voice vote, the Planning Committee approved the October 9th, 2014 Planning Committee minutes.
- C. Mr. Herling noted that the TEAC meeting will be moved to November 11<sup>th</sup> 2014 due to a conflict with the Enhanced Liaison Committee.
- D. Mr. Herling reminded the Planning Committee Members that during the December 4<sup>th</sup> Planning Committee and TEAC meetings, PJM will host a special holiday lunch, as has been in recent years.
- E. Mr. Herling reminded the Planning Committee of upcoming special meetings to review the RTEP Proposal Window lessons learned. These meetings are all posted to the Planning Committee page of pjm.com.

# 2. <u>NERC/RRO UPDATE</u>



Mr. Herman provided the NERC/RRO update. The only standard under development for this month is the TOP-001-3 standard. This standard is posted for industry ballot and comments, both closing on 11/10/2014. It is specific to TOP-001-3. PJM submitted an Affirmative ballot in the previous posting and will be submitting an Affirmative ballot in the present posting. We are reviewing inclusion of a comment to more specifically define 'sustained' and 'momentary' because as written, there may be some ambiguity.

# 3. PJM MANUAL 14B UPDATE FOR PRC-023-3

Mr. Habtemichael reviewed the changes to PJM Manual 14B regarding the implementation of PRC-023-3. Mr. Habtemichael stated that these changes are minor, and if anything will results in less facilities included on the PRC-023 list. Mr. Herling asked the Planning Committee to endorse the Manual 14B changes. Mr. Chu made a motion to endorse the Manual 14B update. Ms. Boci seconded the motion. **IN A VOICE VOTE, THE PLANNING COMMITTEE ENDORSED CHANGES TO MANUAL 14B REGARDING PRC-023-3.** \*

# 4. <u>PSEG ER&T PROBLEM STATEMENT</u>

Mr. Carretta from PSEG reviewed a problem statement regarding Firm Injection Rights and Firm Withdrawal Rights. A few comments were made regarding specific wording choices, and Mr. Carretta accepted two friendly amendments as follows: 1) The last sentence of the 5th paragraph will be amended to say that "NYSIO recognizes PARs as a flow control technology that may be sufficient..." 2) The Expected Overall Duration of Work was extended to 3-6 months. With these amendments Mr. Herling asked the Planning Committee to endorse the problem statement. Mr. Chu made a motion to endorse the problem statement. Ms. Boci seconded the motion. **IN A VOICE VOTE, THE PLANNING COMMITTEE ENDORSED PSEG'S PROBLEM STATEMENT.** \*

# 5. TPL-001-4 R1 AND R7 REVIEW

Mr. Sims reviewed PJM Manual 14B language previously approved by the Planning Committee for upcoming TPL-001-4 requirements R1 and R7. Mr. Sims reviewed the modifications to this language since the previous Planning Committee endorsement. Mr. Herling asked the Planning Committee to endorse the M14B changes. Mr. Syner made a motion to endorse the M14B changes. Mr. Chu seconded the motion. **IN A VOICE VOTE, THE PLANNING COMMITTEE ENDORSED THE CHANGES TOM14B REGARDING TPL-001-4 R1 AND R7.** \*

# 6. M14B DRAFT LANGUAGE FOR MULTI-DRIVER APPROACH

This item was not discussed at the November Planning Committee meeting. PJM expects to have materials for this item at a future meeting of the Planning Committee.

# 7. RELIABILITY ISSUES BY FACILITY TYPE

Mr. Sims provided an overview on how PJM approaches reliability issues for various categories of facilities. Mr. Sims discussed the Markets and Operations transmission facilities lists, monitored facilities tariff facilities and BES facilities with respect to PJM analysis.

# 8. REVIEW OF MOD-032 PROCESS CHANGES

Mr. Thompson updated the planning committee on current initiatives regarding the implementation of the MOD-032 and MOD-033 processes. Mr. Thompson discussed the MMWG case build schedule, the MOD-032 schedule and next steps. Mr. Thompson indicated that he will post a preliminary data requirements document to PJM.com late this



month, and notify the Planning Committee via email.

# 9. PJM LOAD FORECAST MODEL DEVELOPMENT

Mr. Gledhill reviewed an ongoing effort to incorporate electric usage trends into the energy model of the PJM Load Forecast. Mr. Gledhill said that PJM will incorporate a new approach as the E-a tables in this year's Load Forecast report, and begin looking into the trends for potential inclusion in the peak forecast model in the future. Additional information on this topic is available at the Load Analysis Subcommittee website from the 10/16/2014 meeting.

#### 10. SUMMER 2014 PJM LOADS

Mr. Reynolds reviewed analysis of RTO Loads from the summer of 2014. Mr. Reynolds said from a weather perspective the peak day heat index in 2014 was the mildest in 10 years.

#### 11. TPL-007 (GEOMAGNETIC DISTURBANCE MITIGATION)

Mr. Koza provided an update on the draft Geomagnetic Disturbance Mitigation standard, TPL-007. Mr. Koza indicated that there is a 3rd ballot occurring in November on this topic, and PJM is asking members to vote in favor of the TPL-007 standard.
