  - A. Todd Keech, PJM, highlighted important upcoming 2022 Q2 & Q3 implementation dates.

#### Initiative Roadmap Updates (1:10-1:20)

- 3. Initiatives
  - A. Xu Xu, PJM, provided an <u>update</u> on the New FTR Class Types Option Floor that were implemented and reminded stakeholders that the Oct 2022 auction would end at 5 p.m. today
  - B. Bhushan Dhuri, PJM, provided an <u>update</u> on the OASIS NAESB 3.3 changes. Dhuri explained that PJM utilized an opportunity to enhance OASIS performance data by implementing easier downloads for members and that PJM is introducing two new templates, Dynamic Notifications and Security.

## Product Roadmap Updates (1:20-2:20)

- 4. Roadmaps for individual products will be presented
  - A. Kim Warshel, PJM, provided an update on the Markets Gateway <u>roadmap</u>. Warshel communicated that the FERC approved the reserves project on September 1 and that Reserve Price Formation would be implemented on October 1. Warshel reviewed documentation available to prepare for the October 1 implementation and referred stakeholders to the <u>posted</u> Tech Change Forum education session Matt Pennell, PJM, reviewed the new screen changes.
  - B. Maria Baptiste, PJM, provided an update on the eDART roadmap. Baptiste reviewed the upcoming changes/releases and explained the eDART change for the October 1 FERC approved Reserve Price Formation implementation. Baptiste communicated that the Sept 14 eDART Forum presentation also provided details regarding the upcoming release. Baptiste stated that the eDART 2023 migration to Account Manager was still pending and referred stakeholders to the Migration to Account Manager FAQ
  - C. Jonathan Ruffin, PJM, provided an update to the Tools Security <u>roadmap</u> and reminded stakeholders that the PKI Two-Factor cutover only applied to browserless users. Ruffin confirmed only one more tool, DR Hub, scheduled for September 21.
  - D. Anitha Nekkalapudi, PJM, provided an update on the PJM.com <u>roadmap</u>. Nekkalapudi communicated that the solution to resolve the PJM.com slowness required a software update and PJM would provide additional timeline details at the October Tech Change Forum. Nekkalapudi reminded stakeholders that Data Viewer will be redesigned and Data Snapshot would be retired in Q3 2023. In addition Nekkalapudi communicated that the Transmission Cost Information Center (TCIC) will be retired and replaced with a new tool.
  - E. Swapna Kanury, PJM, provided an update on the Data Miner <u>roadmap</u>. Kanury provided updates on Release 22.09 which includes five to six new feeds. Kanury communicated that PJM is currently reviewing the August survey results received and will follow-up with stakeholders afterwards.
  - F. Kevin Hilyard, PJM, reviewed the Secure Share <u>roadmap</u>. Hilyard reviewed the Secure Share completed switchover and Production environment changes that were completed. Hilyard referred stakeholders to reference materials for the retirement of <u>https://sftp.pjm.com</u>



G. Gerry McNamee, PJM, provided an update on the DR Hub, Power Meter, InSchedule, MSRS and Billing Line Item Transfer <u>roadmaps</u>. McNamee communicated there would be a release on Sept 15 to the Train environment and September 30 to the Production environment for the October 1 FERC Reserve Price Formation implementation.

Burkett communicated there would be a release on September 14 to the Membership Management Community that would require additional data request questions, improved user experience flow throughout the form and allow Market Participant application updates.
- I. Amanda Egan, PJM, provided an update on the Account Manager, Bulletin Board, Data Viewer, Messages, Resource Tracker, Voting, and Tools Home <u>roadmap</u>. Egan provided details regarding the Account Manager release that was rescheduled to the Train environment on September 21 and the Production environment on September 28.
