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What is the ACR Triennial Review

- Avoidable Cost Rate (ACR) is a generator's maximum allowable offer into RPM
- Per the Tariff, PJM shall:
 - Review default ACR values to determine values are reasonable
 - Report to PJM stakeholders by September 2012
 - File changes, if any, with FERC by December 2012
