## 1. Administration

PJM reviewed the Anti-Trust Policy, Code of Conduct and Media Participation Policy and performed roll call. The Subcommittee approved the minutes from the March 18, 2014 MSS meeting.

## 2. <u>Power Meter and InSchedule Deadlines</u>

Mr. Eric Hsia, PJM, gave an overview of the various packages developed and the differences between each. One additional package was requested to be added that maintained status quo with respect to submission deadlines but adds Balancing Operating Reserve deviation reconciliation to items that are currently reconciled under the existing timeframe and method.

Ms. Suzanne Coyne, PJM, reviewed the possible mechanics of including Balancing Operating Reserve Deviation Charges in Load Reconciliation. A major impact of including BOR deviations in Load Reconciliation would be that all participants with BOR deviations would be impacted by reconciliation, not just the EDC and LSE.

PJM will issue a poll prior to the May meeting to determine which of the packages garner the most support.

### 3. Credit Subcommittee Updates

Mr. Hal Loomis, PJM, presented updates on several items currently in discussion at the Credit Subcommittee including Credit Available for Virtual Transactions and Billing Line Item Transfers. Current Tariff language describing Credit Available for Virtual Transactions (CAVT) does not match the credit provided in PJM's practice. PJM is proposing to correct the Tariff as current practice reflects the intentions of the FERC order on CAVT. Additionally, PJM is working on an enhancement to minimize a delay in data availability by using preliminary energy-only LMPs in the current exposure credit calculation rather than final LMP values. To reflect the quicker receipt of data, PJM will work with the Credit Subcommittee to consider a Tariff change to relax the member's virtual credit requirements.

Mr. Loomis also discussed the impact of Billing Line Item Transfers on a member's credit calculation. He highlighted an April 15, 2014 credit calculation adjustment that removed BLI Transfer effects in order to mitigate the risk of bankruptcy.

# 4. Capacity Peak Load Contribution (PLC) Charge Reconciliation

Ms. Susan Kenney, PJM, reviewed the current timing related to the submittal of Capacity Peak Load Contribution (PLC) and Network Service Peak Load (NSPL) information. Mr. Hal Loomis, PJM, addressed the concern raised at the March meeting related to potential credit policy enhancements currently being discussed at the Credit



Subcommittee that would be impacted by a PLC deadline shift. Given the credit policy enhancements that are dependent on PLC data availability are still in discussion, Mr. Loomis indicated other viable options will be pursued by the Credit Subcommittee that do not present a conflict with the proposed deadline shift.

Discussion continued regarding the need to shift the deadline to allow enough time for EDCs to meet mandates by the State PUCs to accommodate retail switching with three business days. A proposal to extend the submission deadline to 12 hours after the operating day was discussed. A request was made for data to continue to be uploaded per the current 36 hour deadline, but able to be corrected up to twelve hours after the operating day.

PJM will issue a poll prior to the May meeting to gage support of shifting the deadline. Additionally, PJM will provide legal confirmation regarding potential impacts to PJM documents at the May meeting.

# 5. <u>2014 Power Meter/InSchedule Holiday Deadlines</u>

Mr. Ray Fernandez, PJM, reviewed the 2014 holiday deadlines and introduced Mr. Christopher Werner, AEP, who explained that the current schedule does not align with AEP's holiday calendar. Mr. Werner proposed modifying the submission deadlines from the current schedule (data due on December 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> would be due on the 26<sup>th</sup>), to making the 24<sup>th</sup> a submission day and moving the 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> submissions to the 29<sup>th</sup>. Several EDCs indicated their holiday schedules were in line with the current deadlines.

PJM will issue a poll prior to the May meeting to determine which holiday schedule garners the most support.

## 6. <u>Miscellaneous Settlements Items</u>

Mr. David Budney, PJM, informed the Subcommittee of a significant monthly adjustment that will be included in the April monthly bill related to several Market to Market adjustments with MISO. The adjustment will impact congestion related line items.
