 - 3. PJM will provide a list to the TO's (conducting off-site drills) with the PJM Dispatchers who will travel to their simulation.
 - 4. Mr. Ryan Lifer reminded the members that GO's are not required to participate but can participate at the TO's request (NERC CEH's will be awarded for participation).
 - i. Two PJM Dispatchers will travel to each off-site drill.

- A. Mr. Joshua Berckman provided a demonstration on the new Restoration Drill SharePoint. The site will be utilized and tested by the members at each drill. Additional information will be provided at the next SRCS meeting.
