

# **DRAFT MEETING MINUTES**

PJM Interconnection Capacity Senior Task Force (CSTF) PJM Conference and Training Center June 26, 2013; 9:30 – 4:30 (Meeting #27)

## 1. Administration (9:33 – 9:42)

Mr. Baker called the meeting to order. Ms. Fabiano called roll and reviewed the draft minutes from June 6, 2013 (meeting #26). Minutes were approved and will be posted.

## 2. Demand Response Issues (issue tracking) (9:43 – 12:00)

Mr. Baker discussed the <u>results</u> of the non-binding poll and stakeholders began further education and interest identification on the Demand Response items that were deemed most important. Mr. Langbein and Mr. Bastian presented an overview of the top 5 items selected in the poll and entertained questions.

Stakeholders began the interest gathering step in the <u>Demand-Response Matrix</u>. Additional interests can be emailed to <u>Mr. Baker</u>/<u>Ms. Fabiano</u> prior to the next meeting.

## 3. 2013 BRA Results Review and Multi-year Pricing Mechanism (12:45 – 1:15)

As part of a January 2013 FERC filing that made changes to NEPA, PJM agreed to review the results of the 2013 BRA and gauge stakeholder interest in further discussion of a multi-year pricing mechanism for capacity.

Dr. Sotkiewicz presented a summary of applicable 2013 BRA results, and entertained questions. Stakeholders then took a WebEx poll to indicate whether they would like to continue pursuing this issue.

RESULTS:

Do you wish to continue the discussion and development of a multi-year Pricing Mechanism in 2013?

No Answer 23/58 (40%)

Given the poll results, PJM will discuss how to procedurally move this issue forward and will report back to the group at the next meeting.

## 4. <u>Minimum Offer Price Rule (MOPR) – Unit Specific Review Process (1:15 – 3:45) (issue tracking)</u>

Drs. Sotkiewicz and Bowring presented a PJM/IMM principles <u>memo</u> on the MOPR unit specific review process, and entertained questions.

Stakeholders began the interest gathering step in the <u>MOPR Matrix</u>. Additional interests can be emailed to <u>Mr. Baker/</u><u>Ms. Fabiano</u> prior to the next meeting.



## 5. <u>RTEP/Transmission - Must-offer Exception Deadline (3:45 – 4:15) (issue tracking)</u>

Mr. Baker reviewed the <u>results</u> of the CSTF vote on this item, which was open from Friday June 14<sup>th</sup> – Wednesday June 19<sup>th</sup> and informed the stakeholder that PJM will present a <u>friendly amendment</u> as a first-read at the 6.27.13 MRC to step-down the deadline from September 1, to November 1, 2013, for the 2017/18 delivery year; and September 1 for the 2018/19 delivery years and beyond. The vote at the MRC and MC will occur on August 1.
