Key Product Features

- View and reserve a portion of PJM's net ramp capability
- Review tags linked to an account
- Submit day-ahead bids that align with their real-time interchange transactions.

eTags 1.8.3

- Version 1.8.3 of the e-Tag specification formally introduces the Market Operator (MO) role as a participant on e-Tags. As part of this change, the market operator function of BAs and TSPs, which allows them to perform market adjusts, is now moved under this new role.
- October 10th – Version 1.8.3 will be moved to production
- November 7th – All existing 1.8.2 tags will be terminated
- No member testing is required

- Day Ahead Bid Profile: The ability to create a working profile from a DENIED or WITHDRAWN profile
- Day Ahead Report: Update to the Cleared MW column
- Ramp Reservation & Day Ahead Bid Pages:
 - The ability to copy existing profile intervals
 - Working MWh added
 - Total MWh added
