- Reviewed the download button options. A question was asked whether the CSV was the same layout as previous. Another member mentioned the date is in a different location. PJM will review and determine whether that needs to be adjusted.
- Question regarding the Load Submission page and when that will be finished. That is next on the agenda to work on. We plan on having that for the next meeting.

3. Member questions or feedback for the application

Customers want to be able to:

- Set the boundary limit on the Daily Meter Submission page. They said the limit of 10,000 MW is unreasonable for companies.
- Upload using CSV
- Upload Monthly Meter Corrections (UI/CLI, XML)



- Copy from excel into Power Meter – Update: This function is verified. Further use patterns may be requested to ensure this will fit the member needs.
- Use wildcards or change to 'contains' on the meter account search (currently pjm-sheet component does not support 'contains' search)

4. Release Schedule

We will be releasing the Power Meter application to the Sandbox in December 2013. We will have a member meeting prior to the Train release and we are also planning a technical meeting for the browserless/CLI changes in the next few months.
