- **Project**
 - Approach similar to Tools Refresh Project
 - Begin design, development and testing in 2014
 - Project startup tasks
 - Build base application and generic eMKT functions
 - Implement a subset of eMKT screens
 - Incremental vendor pre-production releases in 2014 to ensure quality
- **Technical**
 - Minimize impact to Oracle layer (business logic and validation)
 - Minimize functionality changes
 - Minimize impact to XML API
 - Refreshed applications support IE9+ and latest versions of Firefox, Chrome & Safari

(Vendor) Begin application development	April 2014
Requirements planning for navigation, integration, security	May 2014
Build eMKT infrastructure	May 2014
First Vendor delivery of eMKT xml. Subsequent code deliveries to follow biweekly through November.	June 2014
Integrate SSO/eSuite and application logging	June 2014
Creation of test scripts for XML and eMKT functions	June 2014
Functional/performance testing for base application and subset of screens	December 2014

Deliverable
Vendor to deliver remaining eMKT screens
Complete performance, security and functional testing
Update eMKT documentation (Training material, User Guides, etc.)
Participant coordination, testing and validation
Production Implementation
