Jackie Roberts is the West Virginia Consumer Advocate. She was President and founder of the Consumer Advocates of PJM, Inc. (2014 – 2015), Secretary and Executive Committee member (since 2014) of the National Association of State Utility Consumer Advocates, and a member of the PJM Interconnection LLC Nomination Committee (2011-2014). In November 2014 she was elected to the North American Reliability Corporation (NERC) Members Committee.

Previously she was an attorney with the Ohio Consumers' Counsel, and corporate counsel to both electric and natural gas utilities (Green Mountain Power in Vermont and EnergyNorth in New Hampshire, predecessor to National Grid. While at EnergyNorth Jackie was Corporate Secretary of three subsidiary natural gas utilities. She was the executive director of the Public Utilities Policy Institute where she served as the consultant to the NH legislature when it passed the first-in-the-nation electric deregulation statute.

Jackie has argued appeals before the Supreme Courts of two states (including the leading natural gas deregulation "take or pay" case in New Hampshire), the Ninth Circuit Court of appeals, and is admitted to practice before the United States Supreme Court and the State Supreme Courts of West Virginia, Ohio, New Hampshire, Vermont, and Nevada.
