



## Jeff Weathers

### Resource Planning Manager Southern Company

Jeff Weathers is the Resource Planning Manager for Southern Company. In his role, he is responsible for leading the coordinated planning process of Southern Company's four retail operating companies to meet the system's capacity and energy requirements. This includes developing annual integrated resource plans, production cost modeling and energy budgeting, evaluating new purchased power agreements, and supporting strategic generation planning initiatives.

Jeff joined Southern Company in 1998 as an engineer at Farley Nuclear Plant. He then joined Southern Company Services in 1999 and progressed through roles of increasing responsibility in system planning, fleet operations, asset management and Southern Power generation development. He became energy analysis manager in 2006, responsible for analysis of system operations and wholesale contracts. In 2011, Jeff became manager of financial and contract services, where he was responsible for wholesale billing and settlement activities for the Intercompany Interchange Contract (IIC), wholesale contracts for the operating companies, and the Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT); as well as the energy analysis function.

Jeff moved into system planning in late 2015 as manager of strategic generation planning with responsibility for energy budgeting, forecasting, model development, asset valuations, and strategic planning analysis. In 2016 he also assumed responsibility for reliability planning, integrated resource planning, and evaluation of new power purchase agreements. His team, Resource Planning, works with Southern Company's four retail operating companies, as well as related planning and operations areas, to develop resource plans that enable the retail operating companies to serve their customers' load and reserve requirements in a clean, safe, reliable, and affordable manner.
