



# Order 1000 Update

**May 10, 2013**  
**MISO-PJM JCM**

- **MISO and PJM have been working with stakeholders since October 2012 to develop proposals and modifications to the MISO-PJM JOA to address the Order 1000 interregional compliance requirements**
  - Have held five joint stakeholder meetings over the last seven months to facilitate those discussions
- **Stakeholders have been given multiple opportunities to provide input and feedback on proposals to enhance the MISO-PJM JOA's coordinated planning process as part of the Order 1000 interregional compliance requirements**

- **MISO and PJM have reached agreement on the interregional coordination procedures, including:**
  - Requiring annual model and data exchange
  - Better defining role and responsibilities of Joint RTO Planning Committee (includes RTO staff) and Interregional Planning Stakeholder Advisory Committee
  - Requiring an annual issues review with stakeholders
  - Adding more detail on the Coordinated System Plan study process (i.e. MISO-PJM interregional study)
  - Enhancements to the coordination procedures for analysis of interconnection and transmission service requests
- **Currently no changes proposed to the cross-border cost allocation procedures**
- **Filing Due Date – July 10, 2013**
