Good afternoon,

On behalf of Manitoba Hydro, I would like to offer feedback on the PJM to MISO Capacity Deliverability proposal as set out in the August 20 MISO-PJM JCM presentation.

MISO has indicated in the presentation that it is proposing to move forward with External NRIS in order to address inefficiencies in transmission capacity utilization from PJM to MISO. We are seeking further clarification on what happens once NRIS is granted in particular, how capacity can be delivered and energy scheduled without the requirement for firm transmission service (NITS or PTP). It is our understanding that the granting of NRIS addresses only part of the issue and that there still needs to be mechanisms in place which will allow for the delivery and scheduling of capacity and energy in the DA/RT.

We would also appreciate if MISO could offer further explanation on how the proposal is “Conceptually similar to PJM Network External Designated Service” (slide 5 of the presentation) or if this has been explained elsewhere, where it can be reviewed.
