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eLRS Data Archiving



- What are we archiving?
 - Registration related information more than 2.5 years older than a registrations termination date. Production and Sandbox environments are affected.
- Why are we archiving?
 - To better manage the amount of information created, captured and replicated on an annual basis.
- Is my historical data protected?
 - Yes, PJM maintains seven years of historical data. eLRS purging will be executed on a daily basis.
- Managing Risk
 - While initial testing is complete, PJM will spend the next month and one-half evaluating and testing data interdependencies within the organization.
- Execution
 - April 15th has been chosen as the start date for production archiving.
- What can I do now to retain historical data?
 - All eLRS views have an Excel download option which will capture the records in the current view into a single Excel File.

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- Downloading Data?
 - In the current view, filter the records you'd like to export.
 - To download data via the eLRS UI, look for the Export to Excel button in the upper right hand corner.
 - Click the export button and save the file to a secure location.
