



Review of DR Participation in Regulation Market

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- No new rules – review/clarification only
- There must be load to be considered "demand" response
 - No load when there are injections
 - Net metering agreement with EDC does not allow DR to provide injections in wholesale market
- Regulation – injections measured at same scan rate as regulation (usually 2 seconds)
- Frequent injectors will not be eligible to participate in regulation as DR
 - Are eligible to participate in regulation market as generation
 - Allowed to participate as DR if take action to prevent future injections

- If site is sub-metered
 - Must also have meter at EDC account level that can monitor injections
 - Meter at same frequency as telemetry scan rate (usually 2 seconds)
 - Accumulator monitoring injections if approved by PJM
 - EDC level meter data to be kept by CSP for audit by PJM for a minimum of 3 months

- If a site injects it was not eligible to participate as DR for that hour
 - CSP should not offer into market that hour
 - If CSP inadvertently offers and clears, should self report to PJM. That hour will not be eligible for payment as DR.
 - If PJM discovers injection during audit, hour will be resettled and not eligible for payment
