Single Sign On and two
factor Authentication

- Refreshed applications moved to new SSO (Gaspipeline, BulletinBoard, Messages, Account Manager, Data Viewer, Data Miner, Exschedule, InSchedule, Power Meter, Resource Tracker, ToolsHome)
- What does it mean? SSO via two factor authentication. UI application vs. Web Services

- Password Length Increase. Users need to reset password every 126 days
- Reminders are sent via email
- Account Self Service Setup Security questions

Session Cookies – 24 Hours

Applies to API calls and Web Services under migrated applications integrated with SSO.

- Details : CAMs will be required to use multi-factor authentication when logging into Account Manager only.
- Other users can opt in to this feature.
- PJM will define the supported authentication factors.

- What you need to do : CAMs should obtain/set up the identified authentication factors.
- Users can opt in to the multi-factor authentication feature.
- Starts 2/14/16

- The below applies to the UI only. Transparent to end users. No change required.
- SSO migration for legacy applications (eMKT, eFTR, eRPM, eLRS, OASIS, MSRS, eCredit)
- Sandbox: 1/12/2016
- Production: 3/22/2016
