## 7. PJM Manual 40 Updates

A red-line copy of Manual 40 was provided to the DTS Members for review and comments last month. Mike Sitarchyk reviewed additional updates to the manual based on feedback that was received from the DTS Members.

The DTS was polled on the manual revisions and there were no additional concerns outside of those which were already discussed. The manual revisions will continue to go through the Stakeholder review process and the DTS will be updated on the progress.

# 8. TO-TOP Matrix Updates for PER-005-2

The DTS was advised that updates to the language in the TO-TOP matrix in regards to PER-005-2 have been drafted and will be shared with the DTS for their review. The DTS will be asked to provide any additional comments prior to the next DTS meeting.

### 9. DTS Review of the 2015 PJM Operator Seminar

The DTS was provided a summary of the comments and feedback that was received during the 2015 Operator Seminar.

As part of our annual evaluation of PJM program activities, the DTS was asked for any additional comments based on the feedback which was shared. DTS members will have the opportunity to continue providing feedback for consideration by completing a brief evaluation which is accessible through the DTS company accounts.

#### 10. Training Items For Review

- Update on IRC Training

The DTS was reminded that the New IRC is in production and the required online JIT training will be available later this this month via the PJM LMS.

<u>Please note the IRC tests will begin</u> on Tuesday, July 7<sup>th</sup> between 15-1600 hours, and then will continue on each Tuesday of the month moving forward. The frequency of the tests may change in late July-early August (more tests added each week). An updated schedule will be provided in July.

June 1st	Release of IRC "New" into production along with the existing version
June 1 <sup>st</sup> – Sept. 1 <sup>st</sup>	Parallel operations for both tools to allow users to get comfortable with the new version
June	<u>Required</u> online JIT (Just-In-Time) training will be rolled out to all Generation Operators via the PJM LMS
July – August Weekly IRC tests will take place to give users the opportunity to test functionality/IR process – Starting on July 7th	



End of August	WebEx Training will be offered prior to "Go-Live" to allow users to ask questions, etc.
September 1st Go-Live for IRC "New" and shut-down of the legacy IRC	

# - Company System Restoration Plan Updates

The process for deviating from an approved company restoration plan was reviewed with the DTS. Based on the TO responsibility per the TO-TOP Matrix (EOP-005-2, R7), if a TO has to deviate from their restoration plan during an event, coordination/communication must take place with PJM.
