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Compliance Bulletin 26 – External TOP Coordination

- Procedurally PJM and PJM TOs have been coordinating with External TOP's in accordance with the NERC Reliability Standard requirements
- CB 26 documents the approach that PJM as the TOP and the individual PJM TOs take to follow the applicable requirements as defined by the NERC Reliability Standards
- CB 26 supplements the individual compliance programs by outlining the functional relationship between the entities and describes the interactions required to fulfill each entities' obligations as prescribed in the relevant NERC Reliability Standards
 - Can be used by External TOPs to augment their internal compliance documentation



Compliance Bulletin 26 – External TOP Coordination

- CB 26 also creates a cross-reference between PJM Manuals and the NERC Reliability Standards
 - Indicates where the assignment of various reliability tasks is documented in the PJM Manuals
- Does not create any new obligations for PJM, its Members, or External entities
- CB 26 will be periodically reviewed and revised, if necessary, by PJM's NERC and Regional Coordination Department with guidance from the PJM RSCS Subcommittee



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- PJM will post Compliance Bulletin 26 prior to April 1st
 - Based on the Standards that are in effect or go into effect on 4/1/17
 - External TOPs and PJM TOs will be notified when the CB is posted
