



2015 Cold Weather Operational Exercise

10/28/2015
SOS Meeting

- November 1st – PJM will identify cold weather exercise eligible units that have not operated in last 8 weeks or have dual fuel capability.
- November 10th – PJM will email generator representatives a list of all units and identify which units are eligible.
- November 20th – Generator resource owners to send completed PJM excel file identifying units for winter testing.
- December 1st – December 31st cold weather exercises.

- PJM will cancel tests by 10 AM the day prior to scheduled exercise.
- Do not assume secondary test time is approved if the primary test time is not approved. All approved tests will be communicated via the PJM Cold Weather Exercise excel file.
- Per M14D Section 7.5.1, Generators shall provide feedback on the winter exercise via PJM Cold Weather Exercise excel file.
- Do not add/delete rows or columns in the PJM Cold Weather Exercise excel file.

- Units will be allowed more than one start attempt during the day-ahead award window, but need to notify the PJM GD prior to attempting additional starts.
- Units that would like to start outside of the day-ahead award window may do so by self scheduling. Note: PJM will not compensate starting costs for self scheduled units.

- Hybrid costs should be a weighting of units running on gas and on oil.
- Hybrid cost schedules should be made available in eMKT prior to day-ahead offer deadline.

- Per M14D Section 7.5.2 – Cold Weather Checklist acknowledgement to be completed by December 15th via eDART
- Refer to M14D Attachment N for PJM's version of cold weather checklist
