BOARD OF MANAGERS MEETING MINUTES

Dec. 20, 2022

A meeting/conference call of the PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM) Board of Managers (Board) was convened at approximately 10 a.m. on Dec. 20, 2022.

2024/2025 RPM BASE RESIDUAL AUCTION ISSUE

- Stu Bresler provided an overview on the auction, including the compressed auction schedule. He further
 explained that there were no significant market rule changes from the 23/24 Base Residual Auction and no new
 Fixed Resource Requirement entities. He summarized the planning parameters, noting that the overall Regional
 Transmission Organization had similar reliability requirements, some Locational Deliverability Areas had
 significant changes, and the Variable Resource Requirement curved slightly up based on the normal escalation
 process.
- Bresler then further reviewed the materials regarding preliminary observations.



Bresler then explained the Delmarva Power & Light South (DPL-S) Locational Deliverability Area and PJM's
concerns with DPL-S Reliability Requirement, including the potentially unjust result if the Reliability Requirement
determined based upon anticipated new entry that in fact did not participate in the auction was allowed to
remain.

Upon a motion duly made, and seconded, the Board approved the proposed Section 205 filing and Section 206 filing to implement a proposed rule change to address this auction result and future similar facts that fit this narrow circumstance.

David Mills was briefed after the fact and did not object to the proposed course of action.
