

Draft Meeting Minutes



Tier 1 Compensation MIC Special Session PJM Conference and Training Center / WebEx February 4, 2015 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. EST

Administration

Ms. Lisa Morelli welcomed stakeholders and reviewed the agenda. Ms. Cheryl Mae Velasco called attention to the Anti-trust and Code of Conduct statements and performed roll call. The meeting minutes from the January 5th meeting were approved.

Review Proposed Workplan

Ms. Morelli reviewed the proposed workplan. From guidance at the previous MIC meeting, this issue will continue to be worked on in special sessions outside of the MIC meeting itself. No requests for changes to the workplan were made.

Education

As requested at the previous meeting, Mr. Michael Olaleye provided a timeline of changes to the Tier 1 estimate across the Markets, Operations, and Settlements systems. The main objective of the timeline is to show that the Settlements system implemented the Tier 1 deselected flag from Markets in July of 2014. Today, all three systems are in synch in terms of calculating the Tier 1 estimate.

Ms. Rebecca Carroll provided a review of the effects of product substitution on market clearing prices. Using illustrative examples, Ms. Carroll showed the scenarios by which a non-zero NSRMCP could occur. If an offline unit that incurs a lost opportunity cost is used to meet the balance of the primary reserve requirement, a non-zero NSRMCP will result. In addition, if an online resource is used to meet the balance of the primary reserve requirement after the synchronized reserve requirement is met, and the effective cost is higher than the offline resources that cleared, the NSRMCP will reflect the cost of the online resource. In this scenario, the NRSMCP will equal the SRMCP since the balance of the primary reserve requirement was met with a Tier 2 resource. The NSRMCP will always be less than or equal to the SRMCP.

Ms. Morelli led the group in a discussion to identify interests surrounding Tier 1 compensation. PJM and Monitoring Analytics met prior to the meeting and pre-populated the matrix with a few ideas. Stakeholders provided additional interests that were documented.

Design Component & Solution Option Development
