FERC Ordered Inter-Regional Coordination w/NYISO

- PJM and NYISO implementing Market-to-Market coordination per FERC Order
 - Market-to-Market:
 - Joint Operating Agreement
 - FERC Compliance Filing 4th Quarter 2011
 - Initial draft provided to Stakeholders on August 12th
 - Revised draft released October 7th
 - Entitlement and Market Flow calculation discussions on-going where noted in the October 7th draft
 - Joint Stakeholder Technical Conference planned for November 3 at NYISO offices
 - Implementation 4th Quarter 2012

FERC Ordered Inter-Regional Coordination w/NYISO

- PJM and NYISO implementing Market-to-Market coordination per FERC Order
 - Interface Pricing:
 - NYISO development efforts underway
 - Testing & Validation 4th Quarter 2011
 - Implementation January 2012



Additional Inter-Regional Coordination Proposals

• MISO

- Interchange Scheduling Optimization
 - Improves efficiency of interface transactions
 - Stakeholder discussions scheduled for Fall 2011
 - PJM hosting initial Stakeholder Meeting November 9th at Chase Center
 - MISO planning another Stakeholder Meeting in December
 - MISO FERC Filing targeted for June 2012
- Capacity Portability
 - Provides Generation Owners access to MISO and PJM capacity markets
- NYISO
 - Inter-Regional Interchange Scheduling (IRIS)
 - Improves efficiency of interface transactions
 - Stakeholder discussions start in 2012 with a targeted 2013 implementation





- Required
 - Market-to-Market Coordination with NYISO by end of 2012
- Stakeholder Feedback Requested on JOA Draft
 - To support NYISO PJM JOA Compliance Filing by end of 4th Quarter 2011
 - Draft JOA and M2M appendix updated and posted October 7th
 - The second Joint Technical Conference with NYISO has been scheduled for November 3 at NYISO offices
- Interchange Optimization
 - Joint stakeholder discussions late Fall 2011 into 2012
 - MISO-PJM Joint Stakeholder Meeting on November 9 at Chase Center
 - MISO planning a follow up Joint Stakeholder Meeting in December
