The joint [Regional Planning Process Task Force](#) (RPPTF) and the [Interconnection Process Senior Task Force](#) (IPSTF) met on September 28, 2011. This meeting covered the following items:

**PJM PLANNING PROCESS STRAWMAN – NEXT STEPS**

A compliance filing is scheduled to occur in January 2012 in regards to foundational elements needed for 2012 RTEP cycle, communications structure of the FYI Process, State RTEP Committee, consideration of assumptions and scenarios, per FYI Process, in existing reliability and market efficiency analyses, consideration of public policy initiatives in scenario analyses and state agreement decision framework, pending further discussion with states. Additional compliance filings are as follows:

- Compliance filing in October 2012 for cost allocation and other issues
- Compliance filing in April 2013 for interregional planning

**RPPTF ITEM – PJM PLANNING PROCESS STRAWMAN – STATE AGREEMENT APPROACH**

The State Agreement Approach Framework defines communications options for states with respect to RTEP process and allows one or more states to decide how to meet policy goals. The framework also ensures integration of state decisions regarding policy goals into RTEP and is completely voluntary. It provides a vehicle for states to take action through the RTEP, but could only be initiated by states. The process would initially provide a high level consideration of multiple drivers and solution alternatives. It also may provide more detailed consideration of specific conceptual projects interested states request be evaluated.
