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## Update and Voting on Proposed Tariff Language

#### KEMA report

- Operational study results support the idea that faster regulation can lead to a lower overall regulation requirement.
- PJM studies based on the operational data show an expected decrease in the total cost of regulation aligning with the new market design and moderate levels of fast-following resources.
- Full study posted on the RPSTF website.

#### Tariff Changes

- The RPSTF proposed tariff language reflects the new bidding, clearing, and settlements structures involved with two-part compensation
  - Both a summary table and a full red-line version are included in the posted materials
- These changes align with FERC Order 755

### Next Steps

- PJM compliance filing by the April 2012 deadline
- Manual language changes for Phase I and II
