To the extent that entities such as AMP are unable to use the Fixed Resource Requirement Alternative, we propose to modify the definition Public Power Entity in the Reliability Assurance Agreement as follows:

1.72 Public Power Entity

Public Power Entity shall mean any agency, authority, or instrumentality of a state or of a political subdivision of a state, or any corporation wholly owned by any one or more of the foregoing, or any nonprofit organization whose membership is limited solely to the foregoing, that is engaged in the generation, transmission, and/or distribution of electric energy.
