M-10 Conforming Changes

- Changes made in alignment with Black Start Filing Docket No. ER 21-1635-00
 - Planned Outage Restrictions for Black Start Units
 - Moved from Section 2.2.4 to new Section 2.5.1
 - Expanded to include both Planned and Maintenance Outages
 - Clarified approval process
 - Clarified Black Start Unit substitution business rules




M-10 Clarifying Changes

- Section 2.1 Generation Outage Reporting Overview
 - Added clarifying language for units that do not have a day-ahead must offer requirement
- Section 2.3.1 Maintenance Outage General Information
 - Clarified the requirements for a resource to transition from a Forced to a Maintenance Outage



M-10 Administrative Changes

- Section 2.1 Generation Outage Reporting Overview
 - Replaced references to eDART ICAP with eDART Reportable MW
- Sections 2.2 Planned Outages and 2.3 Maintenance Outages
 - Aligned times associated with Peak Period with OATT language
- Section 2.5.2 Outage Reporting for Cranking Diesels and Auxiliary Equipment
 - Created as new section under Section 2.5 Outage Reporting for Facilities Providing PJM Black Start Service. No changes to requirements







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
