

Service on PJM of Members' Governing Agreements Rate and Waiver Filings

- In 2018, PJM proposed, as part of a larger Governing Document Enhancement and Clarification Subcommittee ("GDECS") endorsed group of changes, a new Operating Agreement requirement to ensure PJM is properly served with Members' and Interconnection Customers' rate and waiver filings that impact PJM's and the Members' rights and obligations under the PJM Governing Agreements.
- At the time of MRC endorsement, a motion was made to defer consideration of this revision to a later meeting, and it was removed from the September 2018 MRC consent agenda endorsement.



- Rule changes are needed to ensure PJM is served when Members and Interconnection Customers file with FERC (i) rate Tariff filings, service agreement filings, or settlements under the PJM Governing Agreements that impact PJM's or the PJM Members' rights and obligations, or (ii) requests for waiver of any provision of the PJM Governing Agreements.
- Such service requirements will ensure PJM is able to intervene and participate in such proceedings to protect the interests of the PJM Members and markets.



Proposed Stakeholder Process & Timing

- PJM proposes that this work effort be assigned to RMC and seeks to use the CBIR Lite process starting July 2022.
- Key Work Activities and Scope
 - Review and provide education on the need for PJM to be served with rate, waiver and other filings that impact PJM's rights and obligations under the Governing Agreements.
 - Develop a solution to include in the PJM Governing Documents and/or Manuals, as appropriate, that addresses the concern raised in the Problem Statement/Opportunity Statement.
