

Non-Retail Behind the Meter Generation Business Rules Issue Charge Sunset

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- Non-Retail Behind the Meter Generation (NRBTMG) [Issue Charge](#) worked at the Operating Committee in 2019
- Updates to Emergency Operations (M-13) and Generator Operational Requirements (M-14D) endorsed at September 26, 2019 MRC meeting
 - Updates clarified the reporting, netting, and operational requirements of NRBTMG
 - Updates included annual reporting process to determine the total amount of NRBTMG in PJM
- Capacity Exchange system enhancements released in 2020 to facilitate the administration of NRBTMG requirements

Key Work Activities

- ✓ 1) Review the existing NRBTMG business rules in agreements and manuals and identify the rules that would be impacted by efforts to clarify the existing performance requirements² and reporting requirements to ensure that NRBTMG is operating at appropriate levels during emergency conditions.
- ✓ 2) Propose changes, if necessary, to existing NRBTMG business rules in agreements and manuals to clarify the performance requirements, reporting requirements, Member and PJM responsibilities, and processes/procedures needed to administer the requirements.
- ✓ 3) Determine the level of NRBTMG in PJM.
- 4) Evaluate the current level of NRBTMG in PJM as compared to 3000 MW cap and determine if any changes to NRBTMG business rules are needed. In the event the 3000 MW cap is reached, PJM shall, following its normal stakeholder process, make a filing within six months justifying either continuation of the existing rules or any changes to the rules.

Key Activity #4 triggered when total amount of NRBTMG in PJM approaches 3000 MW cap.

- Total amount of Non-Retail BTMG in PJM [posted](#) each year in November
- Amount reported significantly below the 3000 MW cap

- Propose to sunset the NRBTMG Business Rules Issue Charge
- Intend to bring back the Issue Charge and resume work on Key Activity #4 once amount of NRBTMG in PJM approaches 3000 MW cap
 - Additional scope may be considered at that time if appropriate
