

Joint PJM & PJM Transmission Owner Cost Allocation Paper Hearing Responses

Operating Committee October 7, 2021

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- On December 31, 2020, Neptune Regional Transmission System, LLC (Neptune) and Long Power Authority (LIPA) (collectively, MTFs) filed a Complaint against PJM asserting that the use of solution-based DFAX cost allocation methodology as applied to two (2) RTEP projects (comprised of 20 baseline upgrades) in the PSEG Zone is unjust and unreasonable.
- By order dated June 25, 2021 (June 25 Order), FERC established paper hearing procedures in the complaint docket to develop a further record to determine whether the 1% de minimis threshold and netting provisions applied to solution-based DFAX method result in rates that have become unjust and unreasonable.

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- The June 25 Order set forth a series of 14 multi-part questions that PJM and the PJM transmission owners are required to answer.
- PJM and the TOs will submit a joint response on Friday,
 October 8 in reply to the questions set forth in the June 25
 Order and request that the Commission take this response into consideration as it continues to evaluate the complaint.



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
