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SRDTF Work Summary Issue Tracking

April 2021 – September 2021

- Initial effort reviewing concerns with deployment of Synchronize reserves
- Introduced IRD Concept
- Filed proposal, March 4 2022 with stakeholder consensus

August 2022

- FERC Order issued finding IRD proposal unjust and unreasonable
- Actual system conditions not modeled and misalignment between dispatch and pricing

November 2022 – February 2023

- Task Force restarted with updated issue charge to address FERC concerns
- Reviewed IRD concept, deploying synch reserves education
- Reviewed new options to consider for stakeholder feedback




- Narrow scope hinders ability to address FERC concerns
 - The penalty rate for non-performance during synchronized reserve events
 - Reserve Price Formation Impact
 - Limited Spin Response Data since October 1, 2022
 - Potential Reserve procurement changes
- Feasibility and market design concerns with concepts presented to-date



- Task Force has covered all education topics defined in Issue Charge and additional topics related Reserve deployment
- Limited feedback and no formal proposals to-date
- Allows for further Spin Event response data collection
- Allow for holistic review for Reserves with larger scope for future Issue Charge
