- Develop high level process description, addressing

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- Re-design effort is in early formation phase
  - In 2016, PJM is organizing a cross-functional team to review and document “TEAC Today” and brainstorm “TEAC Tomorrow”
  - Teams will examine and document TEAC alternatives that, will include but not be limited to,:
    - Meeting format(s), style(s), frequency
      - Monthly standing meetings
      - Periodic, window or project specific meetings
    - Technology employed
      - Video, real-time collaboration tools, blogging, portals, etc.
    - Meeting scheduling
