



2019 Reserve Requirement Study (RRS) Assumptions

- Study results will re-set IRM and FPR for 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23 and establish initial IRM and FPR for 2023/24.
- 2019 RRS assumptions are similar to those in the 2018 RRS with the addition of OVEC.

- Generator unit model data will be available for review, per Section 2 of Manual 20 and must be performed by PJM Member representatives that own generation. This effort is targeted for June.
- Load Model Time Period Analysis will be presented to the RAAS and PC in June and will seek approval in July.
- Final Report will be presented to the RAAS and PC in September and will seek approval in October.
