Background

- The following proposal needs to be implemented to enable First Ready projects to proceed through PJM's Transition Proposal
- Approximately only 7% of Projects (AE1 AG1) with a cost responsibility greater than \$0 meet PJM Transition Proposal Fast Lane criteria
- This proposal represents an amendment to PJM's Transition Proposal and should have minimal impact to the overall process
- ICs of four (4) companies which represent 10.7 GW of generation interconnection requests sponsored this amendment

Proposed Amendment

Adopts PJM Transition Proposal with the following amendment

- Projects that are the first to cause a network upgrade or have a cost allocation eligibility to a network upgrade for a load flow and short circuit violations that are <u>more than \$5 million</u> will be allowed to enter the fast lane if such network upgrade(s) has been securitized or if the Project(s) opts to provide 100% at-risk security to fully securitize such network upgrade(s)
- No inter-queue cost allocation would occur since network upgrade(s) will be fully securitized with only the driver project and those who contribute to such network upgrade(s)
