- ISO-NE requests [Loss of Source Limit Study](#)
 - On March 27, 2023, letter sent to members of JIPC
 - Determine feasibility of raising the “minimum loss of source value”
 - Documented in the ISO-NE [Transmission, Markets and Services Tariff Procedure to Protect for the Loss of Phase II Imports](#)
 - Requests raising value from 1,200 MW to 2,000 MW
 - Allow for development of large-scale renewables greater than 1,200 MW
 - If study determines the existing system does not support a 2,000 MW value
 - Then determine grid reinforcements to achieve a 2,000 MW value
- JIPC [Acknowledgement](#) posted 8/23/2023
 - ISO-NE will lead the study. PJM and NYISO will collaborate.
 - Study to commence Q4 2023. Duration approximately 18 – 24 months
