FTP Availability in Chromium Browsers – use Internet Explorer when accessing FTP files	Current issue; fix implementation date not identified	Users accessing FTP files on PJM.com and OASIS with Chrome or Edge browsers
PJM Connect Implementation – use and test data from new location	Q4 2022	Users accessing FTP files on PJM.com and OASIS
FTP Retirement – plan to update any automated processes pulling data	March 31, 2023	Users accessing FTP files on PJM.com and OASIS



FTP is no longer available in Chromium browsers. This affects the following FTP areas:

- <ftp://ftp.pjm.com/>
- <ftp://oasisftppr.pjm.com/>

FTP files unavailable in:

- Chrome version M91 or greater
- Edge version 92 greater

Options to access FTP files in the interim:

- Internet Explorer
- FTP client (e.g., Win SCP, Filezilla, Cyberduck)

Solution:

- PJM Connect, which leverages SharePoint to organize projects, documents, data sets and other information
- Will require signing in

Features:

- Ability to pull data automatically
- Option to subscribe to email alerts for data changes
