DR Hub May 2023 Release

- Starting with the 2023/2024 Delivery Year, Load Management and Price Responsive Demand Tests will no longer be scheduled by each CSP.
- Instead, PJM will schedule 2 hour Tests by Zone throughout the Delivery Year which will apply to all CSPs/registrations in the Zone.
- Notifications will be posted on pjm.com to announce a Zone's Testing Window one week in advance and also the day before the actual Test Event date.
- CSPs must use Electronic Notification (Web Services) on the day of the event to determine when registrations are dispatched

Product Details

[DR Hub](#) allows PJM members to administer the registration, notification, meter data and settlement process for Demand Response resources in the PJM markets.

Key Product Features

- User Interface that allows CSP's, EDC's and LSE's to manage tasks, create/ manage locations, registrations and settlements
- Web Services that allows many of the same UI features and includes a polling mechanism for Events

[Power Meter](#) calculates a market participant's actual interchange energy amounts to be used for real-time energy market settlements. Transmission and generation owners submit hourly tie and generator values to be verified and corrected on a next-hour basis.

Key Product Features

- User Interface that allows users to set up meter accounts and manage data submissions and corrections
- Web Services that allows users to upload meter data

[InSchedule](#) is a tool used by power marketers, load serving entities and generation owners in PJM to submit their internal PJM energy schedule data. All PJM internal transactions, including load and generation interchange adjustment modeling and implicit internal Spot Market schedules are handled through InSchedule.

Key Product Features

- Allows participants to submit internal PJM energy schedule data

The [Billing Line Item Transfer](#) tool replaces the current paper process completed with the Declaration of Authority form, allowing users to easily create billing line item transfers online. This tool may be used by PJM participants who want to transfer charges and/or credits to other organizations through their billing. Transfers are created by one party and approved by another party to complete the transfer process.

Key Product Features

- Allows participants to transfer charges and/or credits to other organizations through their billing
