River Marsh Golf Club

Maryland's leading Eastern Shore golf course has two finishing holes that are destined to be some of the region's most talked-about. The 17th is a par 3 that stretches 200 yards from the tips. Awaiting the bold player is a dramatic carry over Shoal Creek to a large putting surface guarded by three artfully crafted bunkers. The green is backdropped by majestic trees and a stunning vista of the broad Choptank River that flows into Chesapeake Bay.

This scenic bike tour will take you through the diverse landscape of the Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge including marshes, hardwood and loblolly pine forests, as well as open farmland, all from the comfort of a flat, paved surface!

Winery Tour

Located just outside of Cambridge, MD, Layton's Chance Winery sits nestled amongst a landscape of quiet rural farmland, forests, and wetlands. Owned by the Layton family who has been farming this area for generations, the winery is unique in its quest to grow grapes in an area typically reserved for grain. Come see how this local family used ingenuity, agricultural experience and good ole' hard work to adapt and create the areas first every winery and commercial vineyard.

Guided Hike

Experience the sights and sounds of nature, quietly walking our trails and paths that folks from all over the country come to enjoy. Our hiking paths are hand selected by our guides based on the season to give you the best possible opportunity to see wildlife, birds and the flora and fauna ware most famously known for. The landscape is flat and most trails are paved or improved woodland paths so no special gear needed, just a pair of walking shoes.

Brewery Tour

Based right here in Cambridge, MD, RaR (Real Ale Revival) Brewing was founded in 2013 by a small group of local, hometown guys. It has enjoyed constant growth ever since, with distribution spanning all over the state of Maryland and beyond. "We built our brewery in an 80-year-old former pool hall and bowling alley with the goal of maintaining the building's history while producing well-balanced American brews 30 barrels at a time. Proudly brewing since the summer of 2013 with no intentions of slowing down, striving to continuously produce products that our community can take pride in".

Trail to Freedom Bus Tour

This tour highlights local heroine, Harriet Tubman. Born right here in Dorchester County, MD, this hero of the Underground Railroad led many enslaved people to freedom in the early 19th century. Hear stories of faith, family and freedom while traveling back roads of the rural landscape she would recognize if here today.
