4. PJM Staff will continue to review a straw proposal for DER Aggregation that seeks to address the various compliance directives in Order 2222. The straw proposal is meant to provide a more holistic view of how PJM staff is initially approaching each topic area, and to serve as a starting place for further collaboration between staff and stakeholders on PJM's compliance filing.

Staff will review remaining items in the Market Design section (size requirements), as well as the Settlements and Coordination sections of the proposal.

5. Daniel Moscovitz, PJM, will provide education on pricing nodes and how they relate to PJM's proposed aggregation model.
