



# Interconnection Projects Update

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- Readiness Reviews and Internal Transition Debrief
- Shift to GIA Drafting for Expedited Process
- Study Deposit for AE1-AG1 in Transition
- Upcoming DocuSign Purge

- 734 AE1-AG1 projects were eligible for Transition
  - 112 projects did not provide readiness packages
- 622 projects provided Transition Readiness packages
- 616 projects were approved into Transition
  - 6 withdrawn for not meeting readiness requirements
- Readiness Reviews complete first week of December

- Developer confusion around
  - “LSAT Comments to Interconnection Customer” in QP
  - When space utilization for multiple projects using a site is required
  - What officer certification serves as evidence of and what is doesn't
  - When a landowner attestation is needed
- Took too long
- New issues found in site control review

- PJM has held internal debriefs around LoC/wire process, site control/plan review, IT tools, etc.
- PJM will continue to update the IPS going forward
- More substantial and concrete changes in coming months

- PJM will issue GIA/WMPA for fast lane eligible projects based on queue order and study completion
  - Fast lane projects still have serial seniority and that needs to be respected
- Main impediments to study completion
  - Facilities study (Physical interconnection and reliability driven upgrades)
  - Stability study
    - If there are outstanding stability data clarifications, work to close out as quickly as possible
- When all studies are complete, PJM will begin drafting GIA/WMPA

- PJM has deposit on hand for projects in Transition
- Study work draws on these funds
  - TO facility study work, PJM stability study, legal drafting and review of agreements, etc.
- Project Developers pay the actual cost of studies
- For many transition projects, the actual costs will exceed deposit on hand.
- PJM is evaluating study deposits on hand and will reach out to Project Developers with low deposit balance
  - **PJM does not want an error in paying an invoice to cause a project to be withdrawn**

- Tariff, Part VII, Subpart B, section 304
  - **Applicant is responsible for**, and must pay, **all actual study costs**. If Transmission Provider sends Applicant notification of additional study costs, then Applicant must either: (i) **pay all additional study costs within 20 Business Days** of Transmission Provider sending the notification of such additional study costs or (ii) withdraw its New Service Request. **If Applicant fails** to complete either (i) or (ii), then Transmission Provider shall deem the New Service Request to be **terminated and withdrawn**.



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
